**Terms and Conditions**

- As a volunteer I understand that I will need to be happy to participate in the cycle tour and perform varied job functions as outlined by the cycle tour director. Hours of work will be long and physical work may be required. I understand that whilst my food and accommodation costs will be covered, there will be no other monetary compensation for my services. I understand that transport to and from the start of the tour and Park fees will be for my own account
- Should any driver behave in such a way that it affects either the enjoyment or safety of themselves or other cyclists, that member will be warned and if need be, evicted off the cycle tour without compensation
- Drivers may not deviate from the official route
- Please be aware that this cycle tour may take you into close contact with wild animals. Neither the organisations, the sponsors, nor their employees, nor agents can be held responsible for any injury or incident on the safari
- The ranger's, guide's and official's word is final! The safety precautions need to be taken seriously, and strictly adhered to. Anyone found in contravention of the officials or any safety regulations will be evicted from the tour without compensation
- An optional, but recommended added safety precaution is a 'bear banger' These 'bear bangers' are similar to a pencil flare thunder flash and are used by many safari guides throughout Southern Africa. These bear bangers have been known to stop threatening wildlife in their tracks. These can be pre purchased in advance and we recommend that every cyclist has one. Details on the 'bear bangers' can be found on the optional extras page.

**Health**

- As the cycle tour will be traveling through a malaria area, please consult your doctor re anti-malaria precautions. Having said that, we have chosen to travel at a dry time of the year, when the risk of malaria is low

**Insurance**

- It is a condition of the cycle tour, that it is the sole responsibility of each participant to ensure that they carry comprehensive medial aid or medical insurance cover. Please ensure that your medical cover includes emergency evacuation insurance. This will ensure that, in the event of a medical emergency, you can be airlifted to the nearest hospital. Driver and Co-Drivers will be charged directly by the relevant service providers for any emergency services they may require.
